Searching for Survivors:

The Fate of the

St. Louis Passengers

with **Scott Miller, Ph.D.**

Director, Curatorial Affairs,
United States Holocaust Memorial Museum



The voyage of the refugee ship St. Louis has come to symbolize America's indifference to the plight of Jewish refugees during the Holocaust. In early June 1939 the St. Louis, carrying over 900 Jewish passengers fleeing Nazi Germany, was denied entry to both Cuba and the United States. After sailing tantalizingly close to the shores of Miami Beach, the ship had to sail back to Europe. The fate of the passengers remained an unsolved mystery for over sixty years.

Scott Miller, Director of Curatorial Affairs at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum and co-author of *Refuge Denied: the St. Louis Passengers and the Holocaust*, will tell the story of the museum's search for the 837 passengers of the St. Louis, and will discuss the consequences and lessons learned from a refugee policy of bystanding.



ABOUT SCOTT MILLER, Ph.D.

Dr. Miller has worked at the Holocaust Museum since 1989. Prior to the opening of the Holocaust Museum to the public in 1993, Scott was a research historian for the museum's Wiener Learning Center – a multimedia information center on the Holocaust. In 2001 Dr. Miller was appointed Director of the Benjamin and Victoria (Need) Registry of Holocaust Survivors – the Holocaust Museum's names information and tracing center.

In 2008 he assumed his current position as Director of Curatorial Affairs, which oversees the Museum's archival, artifact, photo, film, music and oral history collections.

Dr. Miller co-edited with Benedict (Ben) The Nazis' Last Victims: The Holocaust in Hungary (Wayne State University Press, 1998), and has co-authored with Sarah Ogilvie *Refuge Denied – The St. Louis Passengers*.

and the Holocaust (University of Wisconsin Press, 2006), the story of their search for the St. Louis passengers. He has also taught Jewish History for the Jewish Studies Program at American University, in Washington, DC.
